Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • CoVantage Credit Union has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>CoVantage Credit Union does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</li> </ul>
Joint marketing	<ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Our joint marketing partner is TruStage.</li> </ul>
