



GRANT APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Mission

The mission of CoVantage Cares Foundation, Inc. (The Foundation) is to provide funds to non-profit organizations that provide assistance to individuals, especially those experiencing significant financial challenge, and to non-profit organizations working to enhance the quality of life of residents living in the communities served by CoVantage Credit Union.

The Foundation fulfills its mission by providing grants that:

- Align with the Foundations mission and support basic needs, community enhancement and financial literacy and education needs.
- Prioritize projects and programs that create a lasting impact and impression while showcasing significant capacity and credibility.
- Have a geographic focus in the areas that CoVantage serves, especially near office locations.
- Include significant collaboration and community buy-in.

Examples of requests not funded by The Foundation:

- Requests that would primarily benefit sole individuals or would directly benefit CoVantage Credit Union; religious organizations solely for religious purposes; trips or travel; or requests that are not in alignment with the Foundation mission.
- For events and sports/club related requests, please consider partnering with your local CoVantage Credit Union branch.

Application Deadline: Applications must be submitted by 5 p.m. on the first working day of March, June, September, or December.

Application Review and Notification: Requests will be reviewed in January, April, July and October and feedback will be provided within 5 working days of the Cares Foundation quarterly review.
